> FAUSTUS. How comes it, then, that thou art out of hell? MEPHISTOPHELES. Why, this is hell, nor am I out of it. (Christopher Marlowe)

Goethe's Faust: Part II, Fifth act, Open country. Care enters, to lead Faust, in extreme old age, to his death. On the threshold between life and death, memories of his scientific curiosity, the pact with the devil, lustfulness and love's torment, devil's flight and witches' kitchen, take hold of Faust, camouflaged sometimes as a droll story and sometimes as a poetic visual theatre. Science, woman or world: Faust's claim of ownership is led ad absurdum in his death. His happy vision of a free earth: where a free race, in freedom, stand is nothing more than a burst paper bag filled with dust. Does anything remain after this debacle?

And we? Do we remember, what a soul is?

And which poor devil will give us anything for it if it is nothing worth to us?

Musically challenged by Charlotte Wilde's live produced sound installations, the two puppeteers Christoph Bochdansky and Michael Vogel will put on the old hat and bravely go beyond its brim.

THE TEAM

Figurentheater Wilde & Vogel

In 1997 the musician Charlotte Wilde and the puppeteer and puppet maker Michael Vogel started their company, first in Stuttgart, from 2003 in Leipzig, where Wilde & Vogel are co-founders of the International Centre for Animated Theatre Westflügel.

Puppetry and Live-Music are the artistic means of Wilde & Vogel's theatre. Themes and dramatic material for the productions are manifold. They are always questioned concerning the adequate means of expression and reduced to the essence, to open room for imagination beyond the visible for the audience. Apart from classical drama (Hamlet, Faust, Orpheus, Salomé) and adaptations of novels (Krabat, The Hobbit, Frankenstein), musical material (until doomsday, Toccata) or poetry (Spleen, Songs for Alice) there is also a group of performances which base on original themes (Siberia, The Sensibility of the Giants, Dust, Kukułka). Co-operation with directors and colleagues from different artistic fields are essential for Wilde & Vogel and there are several international productions. Since 2007 Westflügel Leipzig has been the premiere theatre and also co-producer of all Wilde & Vogel plays. FITZ Stuttgart has been partner and co-producer since 1997.

Since 1991 she worked freelance in the fields of theatre music, conception of scenic concerts and recitations among others for the Hugo-Wolf-Akademie Stuttgart. 1993 she started her work as a director and writer for the figuren theater tübingen, concentrating on interdisciplinary work between acting, puppetry and music. This occupation led to tours to Japan and Korea and teaching obligations at the College for Music and Performing Arts, Stuttgart. 1997/98 scholarship by the Akademie Schloß Solitude Stuttgart.

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FAUST spielen - Technicals

ROOM:

10 m wide x 7 m depth, complete darkness, dark floor

STAGE & LIGHTS:

- 3 possibilities to hang light things
- 4 power connections 220V/16A on the stage for the sound, seperate from light power circle
- 2 connections to DMX on the stage floor
- 1 DMX connection on the stage to our light computer
- 1 light for audience on DMX
- 6 x PAR 1000W (also possible: PC 1000 W) in very high rooms 10 x all with BLUE filters
- 9 x PC/Fresnell 1000W with shutters, in very high rooms 10 x 1 x GREEN filter
- 3 x S4 (1x with Iris), in rooms with ceiling lower than 3,50m, one needs to be S4 90° with Iris
- 1 x 1000 W flood light
 - No automatic colour changing lights!

FILTERS:

LEE Filters: (HT) 721 Berry Blue (or: (HAT) 716 Mikkel Blue) LEE Filters: (HT) 090 Dark Yellow (or: (HT) 139 Primary Green)

PYRO: Fire, Smoke, Lykopodium are used on the stage for pyro effects

TIME:

- Setting up from 10 h on the day of performance, if performance at 20h), min. 8 h
- Admission of public not longer than 10 minutes before
- Playing time appr. 75 minutes, without intermission
- Taking down takes appr. 90 minutes


TECHNICIANS:

(Light-)Technicians are needed to hang lights and adjust them. We bring our own sound and don't need a sound technician. We also need 2 technicians to help load and unload.

Additional:

- everyone in the audience must be able to see the floor of the stage
- the room must be completely dark and quiet
- audience not more than 200
- we need a place to park the car close to the stage
- we need a dressing room with water and mirror
- 2 hours before the performance we need the room quiet to rehearse and prepare
